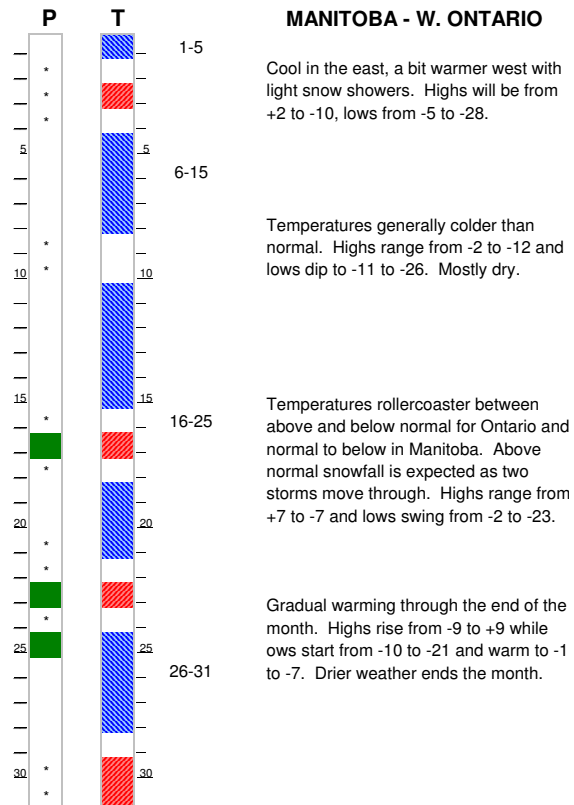
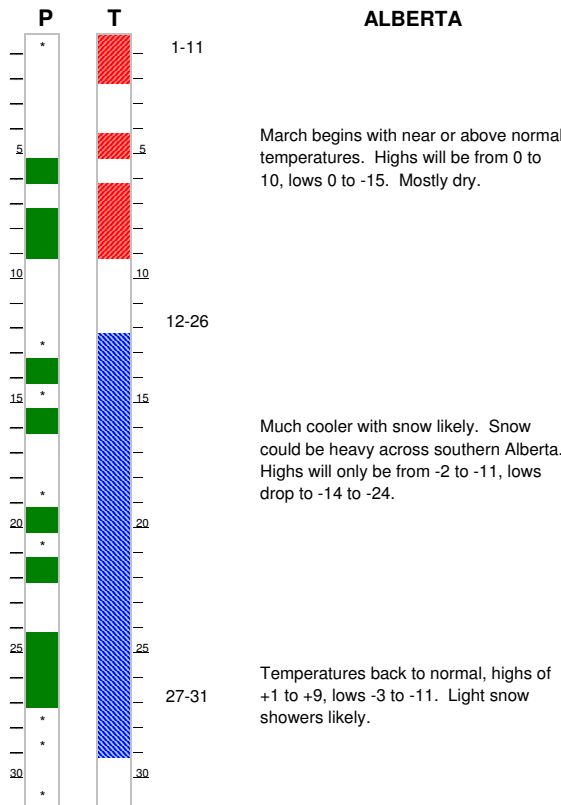
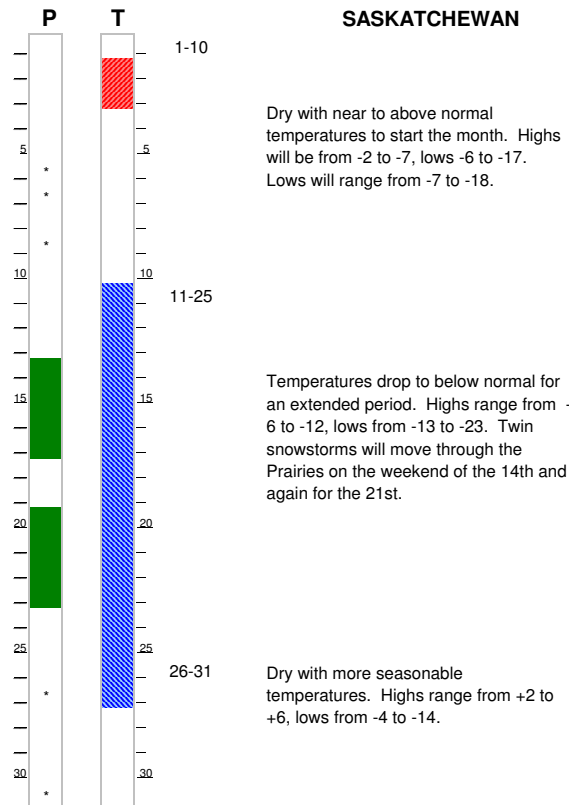
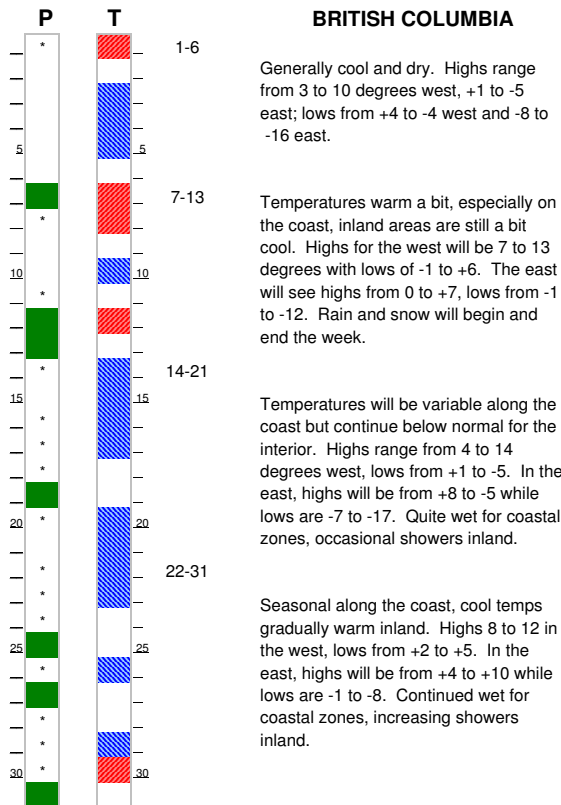
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Monthly Climatic Outlook

Expect a very cold March from the Rockies eastward. The middle two weeks of the month will be the coldest period. Above normal precipitation is expected over British Columbia and western Ontario, with the heaviest coming in the second half of the month. The remainder of western Canada looks to have near or below normal precipitation.
